- Delivery Loading manage parcel and pallet movements by hand, forklift, and related equipment around the dock for loading and unloading of delivery trucks.
- Logistics Coordination team with office personnel to assist with shipping carriers as needed, being about to schedule, modify or provide support for delivery situations.
- Safe Operations ensure upkeep and cleanliness of the warehouse facility and equipment to maintain an organized and safe workspace, as well as reporting service and repair needs.
